## WILDFLOWER CENTER FEATURES

- The Center's **gardens & natural areas** contain more than 600 species of Central Texas native plants.
- Climb to the top of the **Observation Tower** to get a bird's-eye view of the Wildflower Center.
- **Aqueducts and other water features** harvest water for the 70,000-gallon rainwater collection system.
- The **Margaret and Eugene McDermott Learning Center**, a restored 19th century Carriage House, to view current art exhibits.
- Four **nature trails** traverse natural areas, including open savannah meadow, woodlands and limestone karst landscapes as well as our research plots.
- **The Store** is a popular destination for visitors to the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center. It has become a shopping tradition among Central Texans.
